

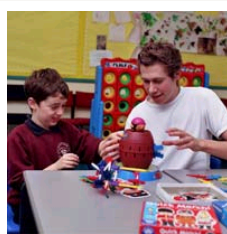
Volunteering for Norwood

Our volunteers work for us in all areas of our many different services.

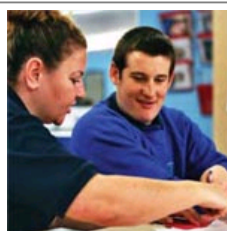
Working with Children we have volunteers who work in our family centre support groups, our educational services, our nursery or directly with families.

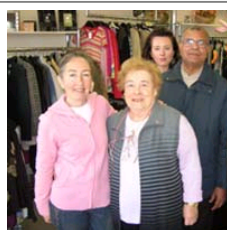
Working with Learning Disabled Adults we have volunteers who work with residents in their own homes or homes that we manage, or at work or on a wide range of social activities.

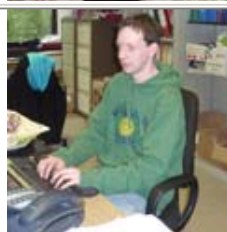
Specialist Support we have skilled professionals who provide therapeutic services in Art, Sport, Speech, Dance and Music
