The evening, which took place in North West London, raised more than **£6,500** for Norwood.



Twenty teams battled it out to answer questions on a range of subjects including music, geography and entertainment. At the end of the evening, the winning team, curiously titled 'Sunday Dancing on Monday', walked away with the top prize of wine and vouchers. Earlier, the whole room had listened in captivated silence as Sidney Regan, whose late son David used Norwood's services for many years, spoke with great emotion about David's life and how Norwood had been there for their family.

Voice of the Balls, Alan Dediccoat said: "It has been a real pleasure being involved once again with the Enterprise Supper Quiz in aid of Norwood, a charity that carries out vital work supporting children and families with disabilities or coping with social difficulties. I wish Norwood every success in the future."
